


## **BOONE COUNTY**SUSTAINABILE ENERGY SUCCESS

Since 2008, over **520** Boone County businesses have participated in the ComEd® Energy Efficiency Program, earning over **\$7.3 million** in total business incentives. These businesses have saved over **95,250,000 kWh** on their annual electric bills.

## **GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS EQUIVALENT**

Boone County businesses' cumulative energy savings provides an annual reduction in carbon dioxide emissions equivalent to:

11,020 homes powered for one year or 65,870 acres of U.S. forests in one year or

10,955 cars removed from the road for one year
